ORDINANCE NO. 2023-1

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING THE TOWN OF LINCOLN ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1 ALL-TERRAIN/UTILITY TASK VEHICLES USE ON TOWN ROADS

WHEREAS, the Town of Lincoln, Wisconsin, currently has in effect an ordinance that bans ATV/UTV (All-Terrain Vehicle/Utility Task Vehicles) traffic on all town roads.

NOW, THEREFORE, The Town Board of the Town of Lincoln does hereby ordain as follows:

SECTION 1 - REPEAL OF EXISTING ORDINANCE NO. 2021-1:

The Town of Lincoln ALL-TERRAIN/UTILITY TASK VEHICLES USE ON TOWN ROADS ORDINANCE, as enacted by Ordinance 2021-1 May 19, 2021, is hereby repealed in its entirety. All provisions within the existing ALL-TERRAIN/UTILITY TASK VEHICLES USE ON TOWN ROADS are null and void upon the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 2 - EFFECTIVE DATE:

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon publication as required by law.

SECTION 3 - SEVERABILITY:

If any provision of this Ordinance or its application to any person or circumstance is held invalid, the invalidity does not affect other provisions or applications of this Ordinance that can be given effect without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Ordinance are severable.

SECTION 4 - PUBLICATION:

The Town Clerk is hereby directed to publish this ordinance in accordance with applicable state law.
